The Winelands is overflowing with farms, each producing their own unique wines offering a range of flavours and tastes. What is often overlooked by the fleeting visitor is the unique way in which each farm tends to their vines.

## Wine Tasting - DeMorgenzon Wines



DeMorgenzon's grape growing ethos is the most unique in the area, they have chosen to pipe Baroque music through the vineyards 24x7, strongly believing that the power of music positively influences the ripening process. Alongside the power of music, DeMorgenzon is home to a powerful landscape set from 200m to nearly 400m above sea level it offers stunning view right across to Cape Town, Table Mountain, Cape Point, Cape Hangklip, and the Hottentots Holland mountains. In Spring specially chosen wildflowers flourish between the vines, which are exposed throughout their fruity wines.

## Wine Tasting and Cellar tour - Hartenberg Wines



A family run Estate, Hartenberg Winery is home to the largest privately owned cellar in South Africa. Commissioned in the late 1980's, the cellar is also a gallery of twelve stunning artworks by German coppersmith, Karl Heinz Wilhelm. They took two years to complete and describe each of the twelve phases of cultivating and producing wine. Enjoy a Cellar tour and Wine Tasting on the slopes of Bottelary Hills bordering Stellenbosch, where nature provides the perfect backdrop to grow, produce and share award-winning wines.

### **Lunch - Picnic at Boschendal**



Enjoy a picnic at Boschendal, set in the Drakenstein Valley surrounded by dramatic mountain landscapes, lush gardens, and vines, the original farmstead complex is now a national monument with a rich and intriguing history of more than 300 years. Explore the vineyards, fruit trees, vegetable gardens and meet the growing herd of free range, Angus cattle. These 100% pastures fed cattle, reflecting the farm's commitment to serving wholesome farm-to-table food.

### **Explore - Boschendal Wine Estate**



Agriculture and a simple farm lifestyle are at the heart of Boschendal. With the options of hiking, mountain biking, exploring the silver-mine caves deep within the Simonsberg mountain range or Stand Up Paddling, Boschendal is a wine farm which has a fantastic array of activities to satisfy absolutely everyone. Boschendal is also one of the oldest farms in South Africa, founded 1685, the farm has grown with the passing centuries into a cherished source of wholesome produce, great wines and happy memories.

### **Wine Tasting - Delaire Graff**



The combination of Maritime and mountain makes Delaire Graff a unique terroir. The cooling Atlantic sea breeze washes over the steeply sloping vineyards leading to a rich intensity of fruit. Delaire Graff wines rank among the most prestigious in the Southern Hemisphere.
